2023 Summer Reading & Math Assignments

Dear Parents & Future 4th grade students,

Summer reading is an integral part in education. Therefore, each student is required to read ***Wonder* by R.J. Palacio** during the summer. After reading, the students are expected to write a **summary**.

The summary needs to include two things:

1. The main events in the story (what happened in the book)
2. What are two things you learned from this story?

In addition, a “**summer activity pack**” will need to be completed. This activity pack incorporates both language arts and math skills. Students are encouraged to complete this gradually and fill in the suns near the front of the packet to monitor their progress. I also included an answer key that can be used as well for guidance if needed.

There are 50 activities in all in this “activity pack” however, only **25** need to be completed. Of course, if more are completed extra credit will be given. For full credit, only **25** pages are needed.

It is also **VERY** important for students to practice their multiplication facts daily. There are great apps, games, etc. to practice multiplication facts. Even simple flashcards are an excellent idea.
